### **Applying for Primary School - Children who were born between 1.9.2013 and 31.8.2014**

Children who were born between 1.9.2013 and 31.8.2014 will be able to start Primary School in September 2018.

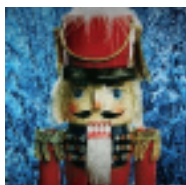
Now is a good time to contact local Primary Schools to ask to look around because you will get an idea of how Reception classes feel at the beginning of the school year. Our advice is to visit without your child in the first instance.

All parents must apply to Oxfordshire County Council for a school place between October 2017 and 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018. This can be done online. You will not receive any forms from Oxfordshire County Council through the post. Please note that applications are not on a 'first come, first served' basis but if you do not apply by the 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018 you are less likely to receive a place at your school of choice.

The Oxfordshire County Council website is full of advice, guidance and information, including a very useful online distance calculator that shows which schools are closest to your home.

**30 Hour Codes**

Parents entitled to the extended 30 hours need to apply **as soon as possible** for their 30 hours eligibility codes. We have been advised that you apply **before 30 November** to make sure you get your code in good time for the spring term starting in January. Not all parents can get a code straight away – HMRC sometimes needs more information to check whether a parent is eligible.

Parents who already have an eligibility code are reminded to reconfirm their eligibility for 30 hours every 3 months. Reconfirmation must take place before **31 December** to secure a place for the spring term in January.
