

## EYPP Report Summer 2019

There were 4 N2 children with EYPP in Summer 2019. The total EYPP funds received was £381.60 (£95.40 each). There was also a 167.80 carry forward. TOTAL: £461.22. Due to the confirmation of N1 EYPP children coming at the end of term, N1 EYPP money will be allocated in the academic year 2019/20. All statistics/data therefore refer to N2 children.

<p>N2 Children with EYPP who are more able in literacy will be facilitated with challenge, enabling them to take the next step in their learning and attain 40-60b in both strands of literacy.</p> <p>N2 children with EYPP who are not yet ready to take part in the phonics challenge group will be supported to take individual next steps in their learning across the curriculum.</p>	<p>Phonics intervention group led by an experienced nursery nurse. Planned and coordinated by a teacher.</p> <p>Additional staffing to replace the member of staff delivering the challenge group. This is particularly important for children with EYPP, in order that they are not disadvantaged by reduced staff supporting their learning during the session.</p> <p>Time to embed skills learnt during the phonics intervention group, through child initiated learning, facilitated by a member of staff.</p>	<p>£419.70 6 hours of nursery nurse time per week.</p> <p>£46.64 1.5 hours Teacher time – contribution towards planning, assessing and leading on delivering the intervention.</p>	<p>Of the four children with EYPP in N2, one attended the phonics challenge group. The child attained 40-60c in both strands of literacy.</p> <p>N2 children with EYPP (there were no N1 children) made accelerated progress in all curriculum areas by the end of the academic year; making an average of 4 steps and in many cases 5 across the curriculum. Particular strengths were children with EYPP making at least 5 steps of progress in PSE3, MA1, MA2 and UW1 and UW2.</p> <p>N2 children with EYPP attained at least 40-60c across the curriculum by the end of the academic year. They attained in line with or within one step of mainstream children across the curriculum. Notably in LIT2, MA1 and MA2, children with EYPP attained an average of 40-60b and in EAD1 and EAD2 40-60a: one attainment grade ahead of mainstream children in each of these areas.</p> <p>At the data entry point there were no confirmed N1 children with EYPP, this was allocated in the time following the data drop.</p>
