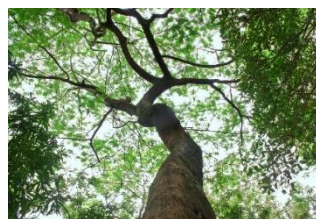
Brexit

Outdoor Days



We will be holding regular outdoor days this term. During these days we will be taking children to our 'nature garden' to learn and explore in this natural environment. The garden is within nursery grounds (it is the land which backs onto the car park).

We will let you know each week if there will be an outdoor day and ask for your help to make sure children have all they need to be ready for this day (for example, that they have their wellies on).

We encourage children to bring a pair of wellies to school every day (we do have some spares). If children arrive at nursery wearing their wellies, please make sure they have a spare pair of dry shoes to put on.

Whilst we encourage children to play outside in all weathers and believe in the mantra 'there is no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing', we are planning outdoor days to take account of the weather that week. This is because we do not want children to have to wait too long whilst adults help them change out of wet clothes once we all come inside. We will therefore aim for dryer days and plan at the start of each week when we will have an 'outdoor day'. Children will still have access to wet play in our main garden on other days.

Research has shown that spending time outdoors helps children develop their self-belief, confidence, learning capacity, enthusiasm, communication, problem-solving skills and emotional well-being.

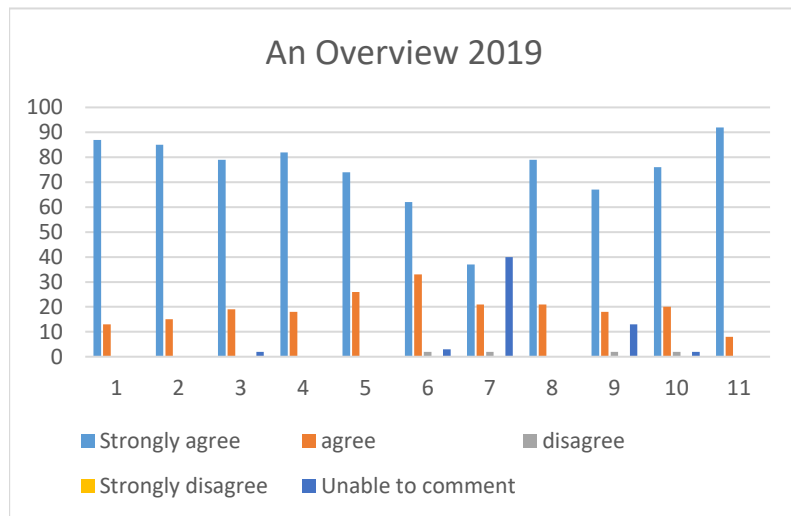
