		TOTAL SPEND: £1160.31	It is relevant that half of the six children with EYPP are summer born and progress for these children tracks across half a term from entry data in October, to end of term data in December. This is in contrast to other children who have more experience of nursery and whose data tracks a whole term from September to December.
